- R Riparian. Areas bordering seasonal streams and tenajas, consisting largely of sycamore and willow

- Oak Woodland. Consisting mainly of coast live oak and the rare Engelmann oak, these areas occur in irregular patterns on the mesas, hills and along stream banks.
- **G Grassland.** *Native bunchgrass prairie occupies much* of the Plateau and is considered to many to be the finest example of bunch grass prairie left in California.
- Coastal Sage Scrub. Areas of low, sparse growth of shrubs such as sagebrush and buckwheat. Includes prickly pear cactus patches.
- C Chaparral. Dense stands of evergreen shrubs and small trees, mainly on the rocky slopes bordering grasslands and oak woodlands.
